First of all, we extend our thanks to all who attended the information days in Ballylongford and Tarbert last month. The events ran from 3:00pm until 9:00pm on Tuesday 2nd April and Wednesday 3rd April and were held in the Ballylongford GAA Hall and Kirby's Lanterns Hotel in Tarbert. Those who attended were able to view display boards addressing a wide range of topics associated with the project including boards on the LNG industry, the processes involved, shipping, environmental studies, planning process, proposed site layout and project benefits, in addition to a video on the LNG industry.

We wish to thank all who helped us organise the events. The events were very well attended attracting a total of nearly 500 people over the two days. A booklet, containing a copy of the boards was issued to each person who attended the information days.

The information days provided the opportunity for people to discuss matters in depth and to have any queries clarified. Some individuals submitted comments via our 'comment forms' and we have noted these and are in the process of reverting to these individuals and have initiated a number of visits.

The next step for the project is the submission of a planning application and we anticipate that this will happen shortly. Copies of the planning application will be available to view locally.
